With 50 years of history, we are recognized as a benchmark global foundation for our commitment to the well-being of people and social progress through multinational programs and activities.

At Fundación MAPFRE, we are aware that only by understanding the new realities of this ever-changing world will we be able to continue advancing in this global project, which is structured across different areas of action. To fulfill our goals, we carry out a wide range of activities worldwide through five areas that have a common objective: our responsible commitment to society.

The five areas in which our activities are articulated are: Social Action. Culture. Health Promotion. **Accident Prevention and Road Safety, Insurance** and Social Protection.

We are recognized by the European Union as an intermediate body for managing the European Social Fund Plus, which is the main instrument with which Europe invests in people.

We also have a Documentation Center that provides a free information service to society on Insurance, Risk Management, and Social Welfare, as well as related fields such as Economics and Law. Additionally, we have the Ageingnomics Research Center, which aims to promote a positive perspective on demographic change based on the economic and social opportunities that an aging population presents.

Social employment project

Promoting access to the labor market:

- Juntos Somos Capaces' (Together We Can): promoting the integration of people with intellectual disabilities into the workplace.
- 'Accedemos' (We Access): grants for hiring for small businesses and not-forprofit organizations.
- Promotion of Rural Employment: supporting projects in collaboration with social organizations.
- 'Soy Cappaz' (I Can Do It) App: downloaded by more than 265,000 users.

#Sésolidario (Show Solidarity) Project

Supporting small not-forprofit organizations.

- Rare diseases: support for people suffering from these types of ailments.
- Support for groups at risk of social exclusion: collaborating on projects with not-for-profit organizations.

International projects

Supporting not-for-profit organizations with education, nutrition, and health projects for children and young people in poverty and/or social exclusion.

European Social Fund

Selecting and supervising labor inclusion projects and rural social and health services. We also held workshops and awareness-raising forums.

Humanitarian Aid Fund

The flooding caused by the 2024 torrential rains destroyed homes, businesses, and dreams. At Fundación MAPFRE, we mobilize resources and collaborate with organizations to provide help, with the same commitment that we also showed in Brazil.

Educational and Awareness Programs

Accident prevention and road safety

- **SDG Planet**: promotes safe mobility through workshops.
- 'Ahora vamos andando al cole' (Now we are walking to school): educational workshops in schools.
- Fire prevention week: activities for fire prevention and self-protection.
- Road safety at the company / 'Elige vivir mejor' (Choose to live better): training courses on new mobility.
- **Goal Zero awareness:** activities to reduce fatalities and injuries caused by traffic accidents.
- 'Te puede pasar/Si controlas, vuelves' (It can happen to you/If you stay in control, you make it home): activities that raise awareness of the effect alcohol and drug use has on driving.
- **Child restraint systems:** web space on the correct use of child restraint systems.

Health promotion

Promotes research and dissemination of knowledge about the economics of aging.

Ignacio H. de Larramendi Research Grants

A reference for those who develop knowledge about health promotion, insurance, and social welfare.

Documentation center

Information resources specialized in insurance, risk management, and social protection.

- **Advanced medical research:** supporting projects dedicated to personalized cell therapies, aimed at the early stages of Parkinson's and Alzheimer's diseases, among others.

Volunteering


The Fundación MAPFRE Volunteering Program improves the living conditions of those most in need. It is aimed at children, adolescents, the elderly, women, and children at risk of social exclusion, as well as people who are sick or have a disability. It comprises six main lines of action: Health, Nutrition, Education, Environment, Emergency Aid, and Sharing Solidarity.

In 2024, we implemented 2,756 volunteering activities in 23 different countries, with the participation of 9,804 unique volunteers.

In 2024, we launched a pilot call for international volunteering, aimed at deepening the consolidation of solidarity awareness in impoverished countries, promoting a culture of solidarity, and contributing to international social projects supported by Fundación MAPFRE.

We strongly encourage a diverse corporate volunteering program, with a variety of activities that everyone can relate to, aimed at channeling the employees' sense of solidarity.
