Ensuring the safety of people and their property, with a special focus on road safety, accident prevention and health.

Improving people's quality of life.

Promoting culture, the arts, literature and historical knowledge.

Raising awareness of the culture of insurance and social protection.

Improving the economic, social and cultural conditions of the most disadvantaged people and sectors of society.

To achieve its objectives, Fundación MAPFRE carries out a wide range of activities all over the world, through five specialized areas: Social Action, Culture, Accident Prevention and Road Safety, Health Promotion, and Insurance and Social Protection. Its activities, which in 2017 were executed in 34 countries, include:

> Supporting the most disadvantaged people or groups within society.

- > Awarding scholarships and research grants.
- > Organizing art exhibitions.
- > Specialist teaching and training activities.
- > Conferences, symposiums, seminars and other events.

> Campaigns and programs directed at accident prevention, road safety and healthy lifestyle choices.

> Publications, both monographic and periodic.

>Carrying out research projects and studies on subjects related to the aims of the Foundation.

> Management and distribution of knowledge through Fundación MAPFRE's Digital Library and a specialized documentation center.

Social Action

Our social action activities are aimed at helping society's most vulnerable groups, through specific actions and correct resource allocation. We operate in all countries where Fundación MAPFRE is present, and always in accordance with clear guidelines. We also promote volunteering and humanitarianism as essential social coexistence values.

Our strategic focus is as follows:

In Spain, we work on employability and labor market integration for vulnerable groups via our **Social Employment Program**, which comprises various projects directed at those at risk of social exclusion. In addition, the **#SéSolidario (Be United)** program channels solidarity by supporting smaller local organizations. Our objective is to progressively roll out this program in all countries where Fundación MAPFRE is present.

In the field of international cooperation, our **International Social Programs**, which are being executed in 23 countries, tackle issues such as poverty and exclusion faced by children and adolescents through more than 90 comprehensive projects related to education, nutrition, health and training.

We also continue developing our **Volunteering Program**, which manages and coordinates the activities of corporate groups that have signed up to our plan, as well as our **Educational Program**, which carries out a wide range of on-site and online activities that foster innovative education and employment.

Culture

Our main activity in this area is the organization of **fine art exhibitions** at our facilities in Madrid and Barcelona, which take in international avant-garde movements from the middle of the 19th century through to the 1950s. We also schedule photography exhibitions featuring internationally renowned artists.

In order to promote better awareness of our activities, we also organize various educational workshops for children and young people, conferences, art courses and numerous publications that complement our exhibition programming.

A number of our exhibitions travel internationally to major institutions, giving us the opportunity to broaden our audience, while at the same time enhancing international awareness of Fundación MAPFRE.

Accident Prevention and Road Safety

Our principal concern is the prevention of all manner of **accidental injuries**, as we firmly believe that the majority of them are avoidable. We pay particular attention to road safety, as the vast majority of injuries and deaths are caused by traffic accidents.

Educating **children and young people** in the prevention of traffic-related accidents, fires, domestic accidents and drowning is one of our key action areas, as well as raising awareness among policymakers, professionals and experts, workers and society in general that it is indeed possible to live in a world with zero serious or fatal injuries. We promote research in the area of injury prevention so as to assist in the design of objective and cost-efficient actions, and we devise intensive media plans to get our message across to society in general.

Our reach is now truly international, with accident prevention and road safety activities being carried out in 22 countries apart from Spain, principally in Latin America, Portugal, Turkey and Malta.

Health Promotion

Our objective is to **improve people's health and quality of life**. To this end, we focus our efforts on the prevention of lifestyle-related non-communicable diseases (which are responsible for three out of four deaths worldwide). We achieve this by promoting healthy lifestyle habits in collaboration with public administrations, and educational and scientific organizations. We pay special attention to the prevention of cardiovascular diseases and promote urgent action in reducing mortality and morbidity.

Our activities span the entire life cycle, from the development of educational programs at schools, health promotion activities in the workplace and family-oriented activities. Our projects are international in scope - in 2016 we worked in 12 different countries, primarily in Latin America, but also in Spain, Malta and Turkey.

In the professional realm, we promote **scientific research and specialized training** for professionals by awarding scholarships and grants, organizing calls for e-learning courses and directing or participating in meetings and scientific congresses related with non-communicable diseases, the assessment of physical injuries, and the clinical safety of patients.

Insurance and Social Protection

Our aim is to promote **knowledge of insurance and social protection**. In this context, our activities are mainly aimed at youngsters, and revolve around educational programs, gamification and courses for professionals. We also make our resources available to society at large via our Insurance and Pensions for All website.

We also contribute to boosting research and innovation in the field of insurance through our prizes and grants.

We publish and distribute reports, research studies and informative guides on insurance and social protection, while our specialized **Documentation Center** assists in broadening our reach.

Conferences and webinars, along with the **bugaMAP** simulation game for companies also feature prominently in our activities.


3 Financial information




In fiscal 2016, Fundación MAPFRE's income totaled 59 million euros, a figure that represents an increase of 40.1 percent with respect to the previous year. This increase, which was incorporated into the initial budget, came about as a result of an increased dividend from Cartera MAPFRE.


Income

figures in millions of euros




Foundational activities, including administration expenses, incurred total costs of 49.8 million euros, 6 percent higher than the previous year.

This amount was primarily allocated to activities related to Social Action (31.8 percent), Culture (31.5 percent), Accident Prevention and Road Safety (18.6 percent), Health Promotion (12.3 percent) and Insurance and Social Protection (5.8 percent).

The surplus for fiscal 2017 amounted to 9.2 million euros.

The budget approved by the Board of Trustees for 2018 will be allocated to activities related to Social Action (30.6 percent), Culture (32.1 percent), Accident Prevention and Road Safety (19.7 percent), Health Promotion (11.8 percent) and Insurance and Social Protection (5.8 percent).

At December 31, 2017, Fundación MAPFRE's equity stood at 2,761.9 million euros.






The amount used to carry out foundational activities, including administration expenses, reached 3.2 million euros, an 11 percent reduction over the previous year.

figures in millions of euros




The amounts used to finance the various activities of the foundation during 2017 were allocated primarily to training (42 percent), prevention and awareness (20 percent), social action (22 percent) and culture (16 percent).

The budget approved by the Board of Trustees for 2018 will be dedicated to the following activity groups:

training (52 percent), prevention and awareness (18 percent), social action (14 percent) and culture (16 percent).

The surplus from fiscal year 2017 was 0.7 million euros.

At December 31, 2017, the Foundation's equity totaled 85.4 million euros.
