to her house?”



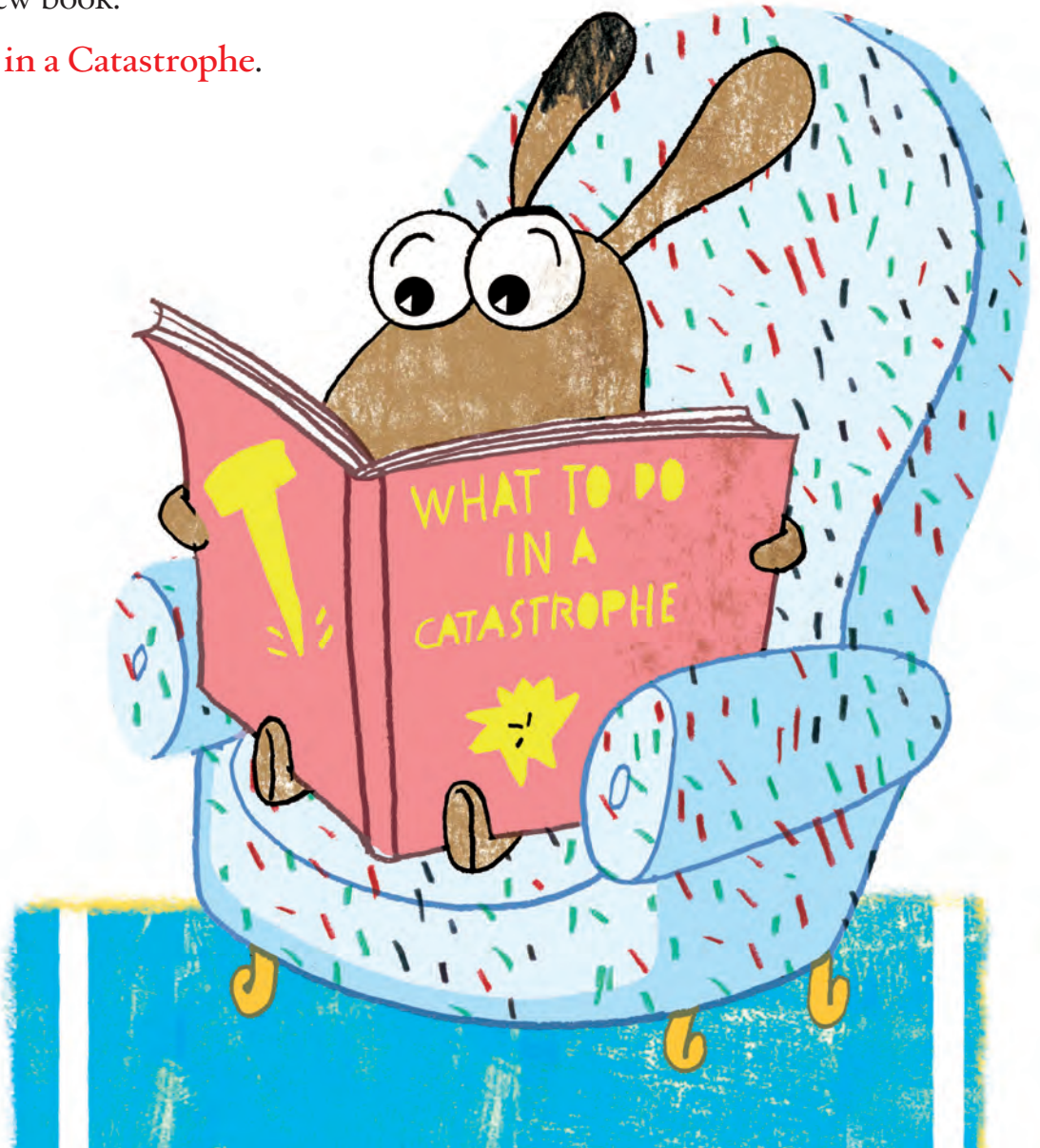
Scaredy-dog has a long list of dangers

What to Do in a Catastrophe.



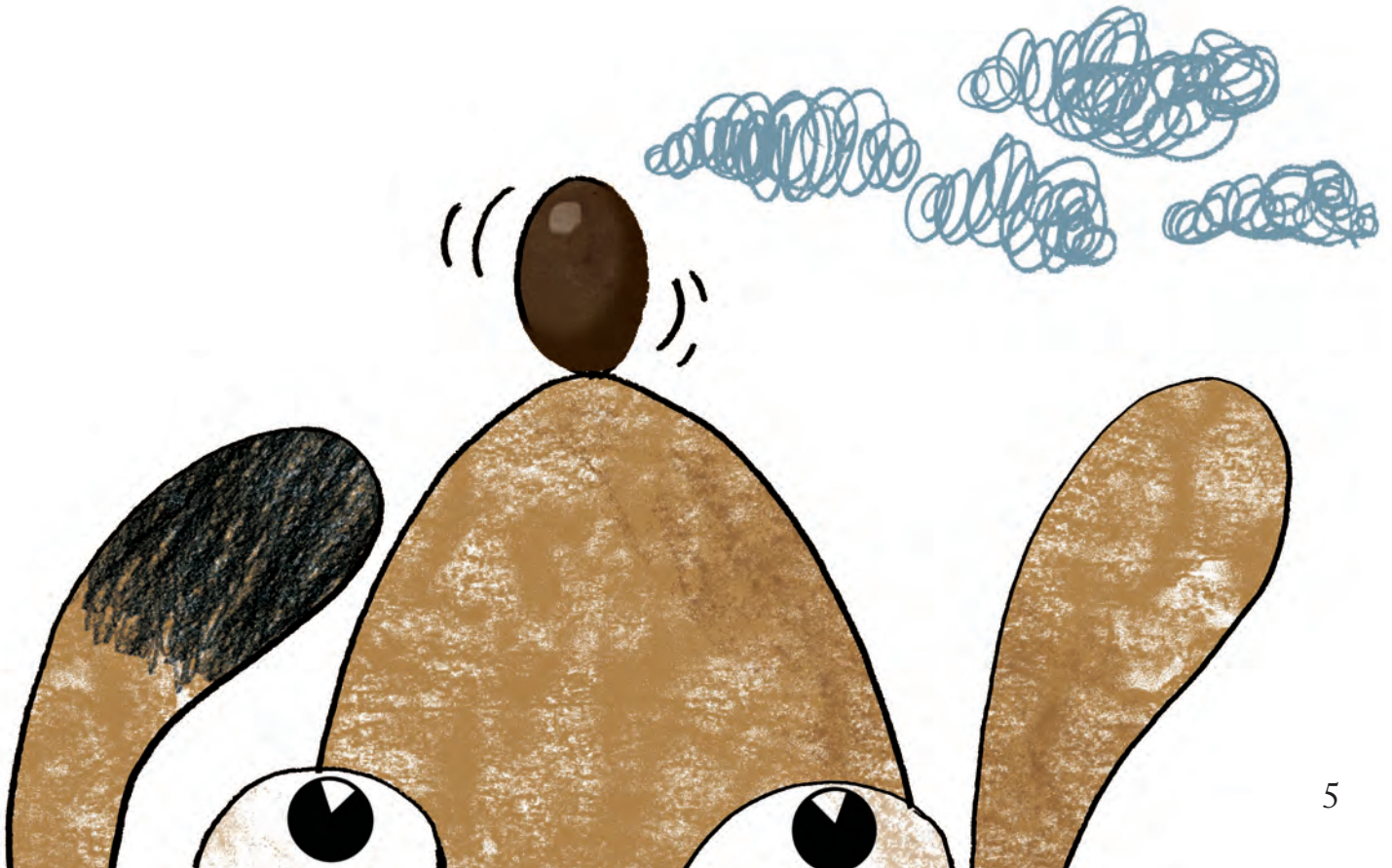
Suddenly Scaredy-dog smells something burning.

“2 to 1... I win!,” he says.

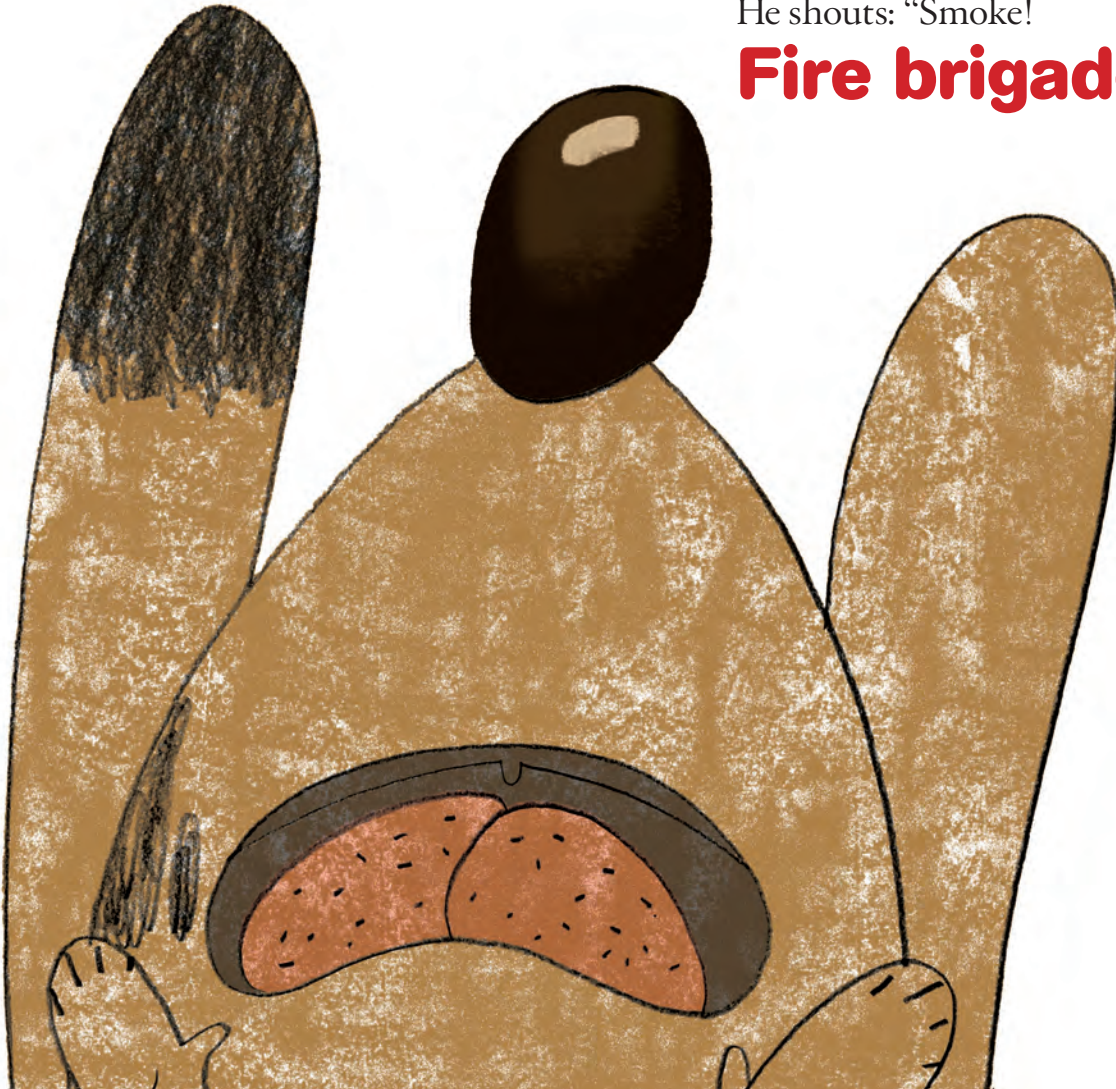


Now he remembers the number is

there isn't a **telephone**.

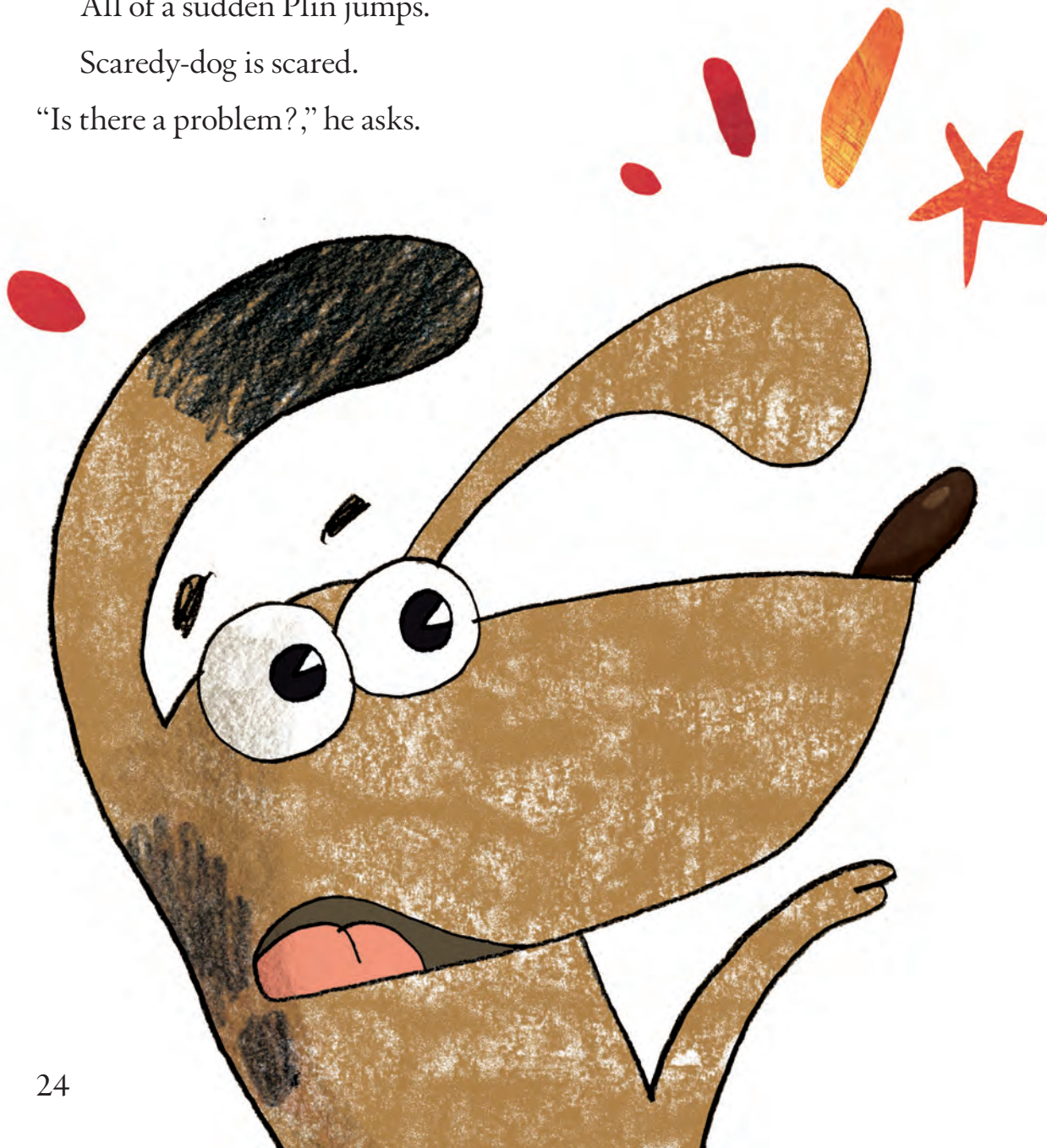


They can't escape
