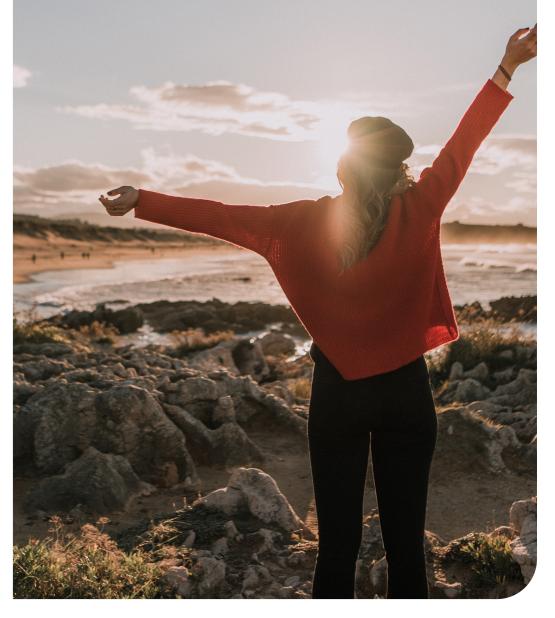

MISSION, VISION, AND VALUES

WE ARE PRESENT IN MORE THAN 30 COUNTRIES AND OUR ACTIVITIES ARE AIMED AT **FIGHTING INEQUALITY AND SPREADING CULTURE AND KNOWLEDGE**, WITH A SPECIAL FOCUS ON ROAD SAFETY, HEALTH AND THE WORLD OF INSURANCE.



We have received different awards throughout 2022:

- Seven Stars of Sports Award from the Community of Madrid for promoting sport.
- Recognition from the Association of Fire Protection Engineering Professionals for our 25-year collaboration and for Fire Prevention Week and similar initiatives developed by Fundación MAPFRE.
- **Special Prize for Classroom Magna 22,** awarded by the e-Learning Insurance Institute, for our teaching and support and ongoing promotion of training in the insurance industry.
- Award from the Young Business Association for our Social Employment Project: Juntos Somos Capaces (Together We Can) and Accedemos.

















1 SOCIAL AID

SOCIAL EMPLOYMENT PROJECT

We promote access to the labor market through two initiatives in Spain and one in Spain and Latin America:

- Juntos Somos Capaces (Together We Can): promotes the integration of people with intellectual disabilities and mental health problems into the workplace.
- •Accedemos: employment grants aimed at small businesses, the self-employed and not-for-profit organizations.
- Soy Cappaz App: has been downloaded by more than 265,000 users in Spain and Latin America.

#SÉSOLIDARIO PROJECT

We provide help and support to the small not-for-profit organizations in Spain that need it the most, so that they in turn can help those who need it most.

- Rare diseases: around 7,000 rare diseases affect 7 percent of the world's population, and in Spain, more than 3 million people suffer from them.
- Assistance to groups at risk of social exclusion: we finance projects undertaken by non-profits. We also carry out sponsorship projects, as well as micro-donations, the Euro Solidario project and awareness-raising actions.
- Action taken in support of the humanitarian crisis caused by the war in Ukraine:
- Fundraising
- Christmas donation initiative

INTERNATIONAL SOLIDARITY PROJECTS

We support not-for-profit organizations that execute comprehensive education projects aimed at children and young people in poverty and/or at risk of social exclusion. In 2022, we met the needs of 133,219 people in 25 countries, through 88 projects in collaboration with 73 local and global organizations.

HUMANITARIAN AID FIIND

We activated our emergency fund at the request of the Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico and Honduras to alleviate the effects of Hurricane Fiona and torrential rains.











2. EDUCATIONAL AND AWARENESS-BAISING PROGRAMS

WORKSHOPS, ACTIVITIES AND CAMPAIGNS... THESE ARE SOME OF THE INITIATIVES UNDERTAKEN IN 2022 TO PROMOTE SAFER MOBILITY, GOOD HEALTH AND TRAINING IN FINANCE AND INSURANCE.

IN ACCIDENT PREVENTION AND ROAD SAFETY

- **SDG Planet:** aimed at second and third cycle students in elementary schools, this program promotes injury prevention and safe, healthy and sustainable mobility through workshops.
- Now we're walking to school: a project in Spain, carried out in conjunction with the STOP Accidentes association, based on educational workshops in schools for children in elementary school.
- Fire Prevention Week: activities to disseminate knowledge on fire prevention and self-protection, aimed mainly at children and the elderly.
- Goal Zero: awareness-raising activities, campaigns and workshops in various countries around the world, which seek to reduce the number of deaths and serious injuries caused by traffic accidents to zero.

IN HEALTH PROMOTION

- Learning to save lives together: training teachers and students from schools and institutes on cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and defibrillation.
- Healthy living: More than 24,000 children from all over Spain have gone through workshops that raise awareness in a fun way about the importance of leading a healthy life.
- Control Your Network: program for students from 3rd and 4th Grade in elementary school, their families and teachers, with the objective being to know how to use information and communication technologies correctly and in a healthful manner.

IN INSURANCE AND SOCIAL PROTECTION

- PlayPension: a game in which students aged 16 to 18 learn how to manage a family budget.
- Insurance and Pensions for All: content on websites and social networks focused on investing and financial well-being.
- Financial Education Day and Week: campaign to disseminate short informational clips on social networks with tips to avoid falling victim to online scams.









3. INNOVATION AND KNOWLEDGE PROMOTION

PUBLICATIONS

We released publications on road safety, fire prevention, health, insurance and art. The MAPFRE Insurance Dictionary is an essential digital consultation resource.

IGNACIO H. DE LARRAMENDI RESEARCH GRANTS

In 2022 we invested 300,000 euros in 12 projects related to health promotion, insurance and social protection.

ADVANCED MEDICAL RESEARCH

We support, among others, projects centered on personalized cell therapy, therapies treating the early stages of Parkinson's disease, Alzheimer's disease and other neurodegenerative diseases, and cardiovascular ailments.

DOCUMENTATION CENTER

We attended to more than 1,500 queries and our newsletter updates are received by 4,700 subscribers.

ERASMUS + PROGRAM: PROYECTO ENDING

This initiative aims to reduce school dropout rates caused by the misuse of digital technologies.

AGEINGNOMICS RESEARCH CENTER

Promotes research and dissemination of knowledge on the economics of aging.











5. VOLUNTEERING

The Fundación MAPFRE Volunteering Program improves the living conditions of those most in need. It also promotes **environmental education** and provides a healthy social outlet for our volunteers, the best ambassadors of our values.

The program is aimed at children, adolescents, the elderly, women and children at risk of social exclusion, as well as people with illnesses or disabilities. It comprises six main lines of action: **Health, Nutrition, Education, Environment, Emergency Aid and Share Solidarity.**

In 2022, we carried out **1,626 activities** in **25 countries**, with the participation of **4,386 unique volunteers**, many of them accompanied by younger family members: 207 this year.









6. EXHIBITIONS

RecoletoS exhibition hall - KBR

Since 2020, the Recoletos exhibition hall in Madrid has hosted programs centered on plastic arts and photography. This approach has been stimulating for the public who choose to visit one exhibition and end up visiting both.

Our Recoletos exhibition halls hosted a grand retrospective of 17th to 19th century French art, as well as the Julio González-Pablo Picasso exhibition, in addition to photography by Pérez Siquier, Jorge Ribalta and Ilse Bing. KBR hosted works by Lee Friedlander, Adolf Mas and Bleda and Rosa.

Travelling and online exhibitions

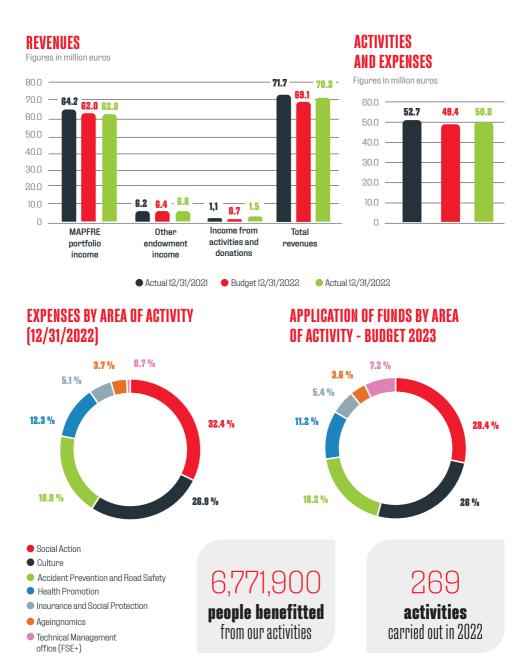

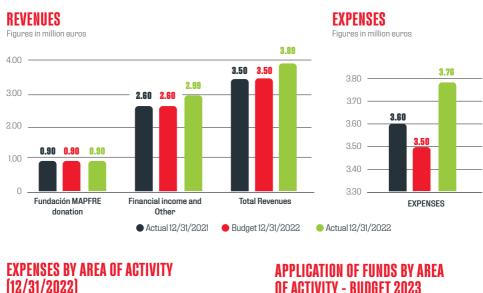
4. CULTURAL ACTIVITY

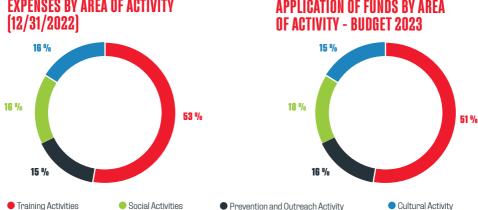
