Some facts and figures...

- National Associations of Insurance and Risk Management appeared in Europe in the early 70's
- In 1974, six of them decided to create a European Federation called AFAI
- In 1986, AEAI became FERMA with 10 associations
- Today FERMA gathers 22
 Associations in 20 countries and is still growing
 - Representing over 4800 risk and insurance managers
 - Cross Sectors (80% Private and 20% Public)

- President summit in October





Objectives & Benefits of the Survey

- Unique survey conducted by Risk Managers
- To identify European, national and sector-specific practices & trends around:
 - ✓ Risk governance (Board involvement)
 - ✓ Role of Risk Management & Risk Manager
 - ✓ Level of maturity of Risk Management systems and processes
 - ✓ Level of globalisation and complexity of insurance programmes as well as Risk Managers' definition of value provided by insurers
 - ✓ Degree to which insurance management supports overall Risk Management
 - ✓ Current regulatory and other issues
 - ✓ Have a better understanding of stakeholders expectations in the current difficult economic & financial situation
 - ✓ Assessment of the level of deployment of the 8th EU Company Law Directive
- Report is an Internal tool for Risk Managers to convey ideas and to promote actions and provides members with a clear view on risk management and insurance in Europe.



Structure of the Survey: 3 Sections

✓ Risk Governance
